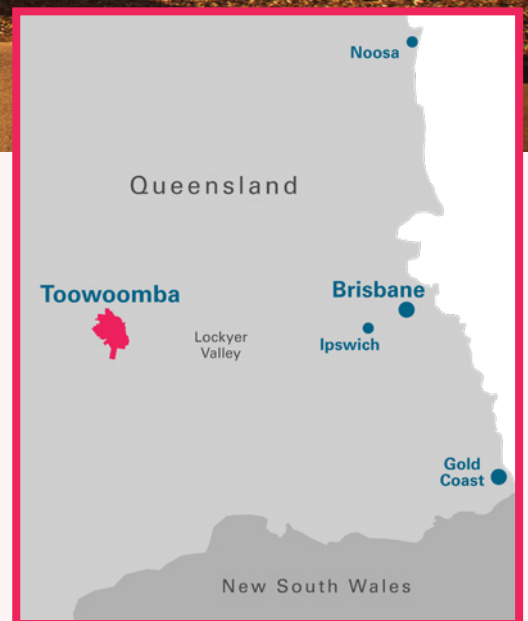


Welcome to

Public Schools

Toowoomba North State School

Located at 10 Taylor Street, Toowoomba City.

Toowoomba East State School

Situated at 50 Arthur Street, East Toowoomba.

Harristown State High School

Offers classes from Year 7 to Year 12.

Darling Heights State School

Serving students from Prep to Year 7.

Gowrie State School

Located in Gowrie Junction, offering classes from Prep to Year 7.

Toowoomba West Special School

Located in Newtown, providing specialised education.

Private Schools

Toowoomba Grammar School

An independent, non-denominational, day and boarding school for boys, located at 24 Margaret Street.

The Glennie School

An Anglican girls' school from Kindy to Year 12, located at 246a Herries Street.

Downlands College

A co-educational day school from Prep to Year 12, located in Toowoomba City.

St. Saviour's Primary School

A Catholic primary school offering co-educational education from Prep to Year 6.

St. Mary's College

An independent Catholic school for girls from Prep to Year 12.

University

Childcare Centres

Picnic Point
